From Pastor Glenn

I am honored to be asked to *help* lead our church, our body of Christ, and to conduct our worship into a new year. For that's what we're doing: preparing ourselves to move forward into a new and exciting year for Bethel Church. I have heard laments that we've gotten so small, and we're struggling. I'm sorry, but I don't believe that is exactly true.

I have been preaching in a lot of churches in the last two years. One church has indeed closed its doors. One has gone from two services to one. Some, unfortunately, are open with congregations much smaller than our choir. And they certainly don't have a choir like LuAnn Sanor has gathered for Bethel. You see, Carole and I look at Bethel and marvel at all this church does. Every week a significant gathering comes to worship God and be thankful for our Savior Jesus Christ. Children have been served in some new ways in this building. Many desperate people depend on us to stretch their meager meals to strengthen their bodies.

In addition, we support our church's mission to a reasonable extent, but we are also reaching farther with our significant gifts. We support several local helping agencies, and this summer Jim Buttermore has made sure we heard about each one and where our money goes. Plus, we regularly reach halfway around the world to support a medical clinic in war- torn Ukraine.

I am proud to be associated with this body of Christ. We are doing the work of Christ on several fronts and doing it well. But we've got to believe it! And I know that some of the things we do can grow. We're not going backwards.

In the 13 years I've been a member, we have grown our programs and I am proud. Now if we believe in ourselves, and in the mission, we are called to by Jesus Christ, we will return to working together, helping God's needy people, and loving one another.

I pray that I will be able to inspire you to that. We have a great working team. Carole and I have been looking critically at what has been happening the last three or four weeks. Decisions were made by the book. Everything we have done has been compassionate and generous. We don't have a lot of rubble to step over or clean up as we move forward. We just must build on who and what we are, and that is the body of Christ. Yes, all of you (not *some* of you) are being asked to go along with us and pick up a piece of the work with us.
